

AGREEMENT FOR INTERDISTRICT COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES

This agreement is hereby entered into by and between Highline School District No. 401, King County, Washington, hereinafter referred to as the “serving” district and the following Washington State school districts:

Kent	School District	#415	King County
Mercer Island	School District	#400	King County
Renton	School District	#403	King County
Tahoma	School District	#409	King County
Tukwila	School District	#406	King County

The purpose of this agreement is to utilize interdistrict cooperative as authorized by RCW 28A.58.0785, RCW 28A.59.245 and Chapter 392-135 WAC, to provide educational programs not otherwise available and to avoid duplication of specialized programs and facilities. These objectives will be achieved by the following described cooperative programs.

The programs will be administered in accordance with state statutes and Washington State Administrative Code governing the education of students with disabilities.

The Highline School District will serve an average of 22 students as follows:

8	from Kent	School District	#415	King County
1	from Mercer Island	School District	#400	King County
5	from Renton	School District	#403	King County
1	from Tahoma	School District	#409	King County
1	from Tukwila	School District	#406	King County

It is established that the districts above will be billed for the costs below to operate the cooperative program for the 2009-2010 school year for their students. Any costs beyond those listed below shall be discussed and agreed upon by both parties. The Highline School District agrees to provide current Individualized Education Program (IEP) and Evaluation reports to the districts above for the students covered by this Agreement.

Elementary Deaf & Hard of Hearing	\$28,800
Secondary Deaf & Hard of Hearing	\$38,400

Each student requiring additional paraeducator support will have that staff person's cost billed to the participating district.

Billing will be done three times during the school year and be based on the average cost per student in each of the above programs. Actual costs will vary from the above amount.
